This week our assemblies have covered the following:

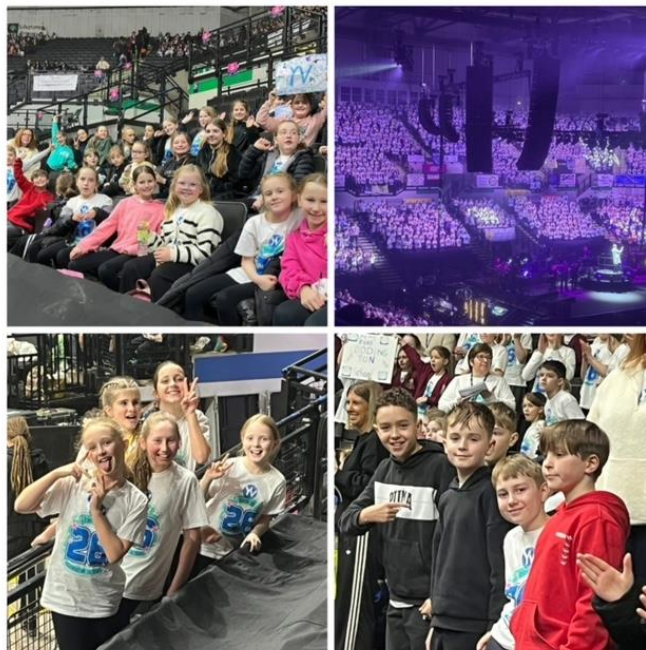
Monday - Mrs Rosamond led a singing assembly.
